DEFINITIONS

Student fees are funds assessed from the student body and restricted to support of intercollegiate athletics.

State subsidies are state, municipal, federal and other government appropriations made in support of the operations of intercollegiate athletics.

School subsidies are institutional resources allocated to athletics, which may also include unrestricted funds from government sources (e.g., state funds, tuition, transfers, Federal Work Study funds).

Administrative subsidies include the value of facilities and services provided by the institution and not charged to athletics, such as allocations for administrative costs, facilities and maintenance, field and grounds maintenance, security, etc.
